### LEFKOWSKI ANNOUNCED TO NEW ENGLAND DIVISION III SENIOR ALL-STAR SQUAD

April 12, 2000

Men's basketball standout Justin Lefkowski (Torrington, CT/Torrington H.S.) is one of thirteen members of the New England Basketball Coaches Division III South All-Star Team to participate in tonight's all-star game versus the North All-Stars at the Hart Center on the campus of the College of the Holy Cross at 6:00 p.m. The two squads were announced by John Scheinman, Executive Director of the New England Basketball Coaches Association.



Lefkowski, who played center for the Lyons, started in every game for the past three seasons. He has been the team's leading scorer the last two years and will leave Wheaton having the distinction of playing in the most games ever in any player's four-year career.

During his senior season, Lefkowski averaged team-high's of 5.9 rebounds per game, a mark good enough for a 12th place standing in the New England Women's and Men's Athletic Conference (NEWMAC), and 10.7 points per contest. He also ranked eighth in the conference in field goal percentage, shooting .485 from the field on 98-202 FG. In addition to his league ranking, Lefkowski was tied for second on the team in steals (28) and third in blocked shots (10).

The Lyons, winners of their first regular season NEWMAC Championship, automatically received a first-round bye in the conference tournament. Springfield College, a team that participated in the 2000 NCAA Division III Sectional Tournament, ended the Lyons' national aspirations with a 55-51 win in the semifinal game.

In the region, Wheaton qualified for its second consecutive trip to the Eastern College Athletic Conference (ECAC) Men's Basketball Championship, falling to the White Mules of Colby College in the first round.

### **MEN'S BASKETBALL IS ECAC BOUND, SET TO FACE COLBY COLLEGE IN OPENING ROUND**

February 29, 2000

The 1999-2000 Wheaton College men's basketball team has earned the number-seven seed in this year's Eastern College Athletic Conference (ECAC) Men's Basketball Championship. Wheaton will travel to Waterville, ME to face the second-seeded Colby College White Mules on Wednesday, March 1 at 6:00 p.m.



The Lyons, who finished regular season play with their first New England Women's and Men's Athletic Conference (NEWMAC) Championship, received a first-round bye while advancing to the semifinal round of the conference tournament. Springfield College, a team in which Wheaton had defeated twice during the season, ended the Lyons' five-game winning streak with a 55-51 win at Massachusetts Institute of Technology.

Springfield, the only league team to qualify for the NCAA Tournament, went on to claim the conference tournament title with a victory over Clark University. Clark was the only other NEWMAC school awarded with a bid to the ECAC Tournament.

Wheaton, one of only four teams to defeat number-one seeded Connecticut College this year, is entering this first round contest with an overall mark of 16-8 while Colby, who competes in the New England Small College Athletic Conference (NESCAC), comes into the game at 17-6.

This year marks the second straight season that the Lyons have qualified for the ECAC Tournament, as they were chosen in the 1998-99 campaign as the eighth-seeded team. At 17-10 last year, Wheaton lost to top-seeded Plymouth State College in the preliminary round at Foley Gym in Plymouth, NH.

The highest-seeded team hosts the first round games in the ECAC Tournament, while the highest remaining seed after Wednesday's games will host the semifinals and finals rounds on Saturday, March 4 and Sunday, March 5. In addition to the Wheaton vs. Colby contest, following are the other three first round games this Wednesday:

### WHEATON CLAIMS FIRST NEWMAC REGULAR SEASON TITLE WITH 66-57 WIN OVER SPRINGFIELD COLLEGE

February 19, 2000

With all six seniors playing in the opening minutes of the final regular season home game of their careers, the Wheaton men's basketball team jumped out to a 9-0 lead and never trailed, keeping Springfield College scoreless for five straight minutes, en route to a 66-57 victory and first conference regular season championship in Emerson Gymnasium. The win earned the Lyons a number-one seed and first-round bye in the New England Women's and Men's Athletic Conference (NEWMAC) Tournament.



Wheaton's six seniors accounted for 70% of their team's scoring, led by Arnulfo DeLaCruz (Milton, MA/Milton H.S.) with 12 points and a game-high six assists. Peter Butler (Hamden, CT/Hamden H.S.), in only his second start of the season, scored seven of his team's first nine points. The Lyons contained the Pride's offensive attack and held them in check with a mere eight points midway through the first half, while pushing their own advantage out to 13 points at 23-10 with 8:36 remaining. Springfield cut the deficit down to 29-23 off a Lydell Capers (New York, NY/Hyde School) three-point shot with two minutes to go, but Wheaton scored the final four points of the half to enter the intermission with a 33-23 lead.

In the second half, play remained even while Springfield again cut the Lyon lead to six points at 36-30 in the early minutes. But the momentum quickly turned back to the home team on the strength of three-straight three-point baskets, one coming from senior Bill O'Brien (Taunton, MA/Northfield Mt. Hermon H.S.) and two off the shooting hands of sophomore Luke Gordon (Cherry Valley, MA/St. Peter Marion H.S.). At that point, Wheaton owned the largest lead of the game at 48-34 with just over ten minutes to play, while holding the Pride without a field goal over a 7:21 stretch. Springfield could only get as close as seven points on two occasions late in the game, as the Lyons preserved the victory.

Senior Justin Lefkowski (Torrington, CT/Torrington H.S.) and sophomore Sam Ackah (New Bedford, MA/New Bedford H.S.) rounded out Wheaton's double-figure scoring with 11 points apiece. Butler finished the game with nine points and a team-best nine rebounds.

For Springfield, sophomore Michael Parker (Kingston, NY/Kingston H.S.) led his team in scoring and rebounding with a game-best 25 points (7-12 FG, 10-12 FT) and team-high nine rebounds. Freshmen David White (Medford, MA/Medford H.S.) and Adetokunbo Adewuyi (Providence, RI/Mount Pleasant H.S.) rounded out the Pride's scoring with 12 and 10 points, respectively.

The Lyons extended their winning streak to a season-best five games, as they improved their overall mark to 16-7 and 9-3 in the conference. Springfield fell to 16-8 and 8-4 in the NEWMAC. The Pride drops to a No. 4 seed and will host No. 5 Babson College on Tuesday at 7:00 p.m. Wheaton will play the winner of this contest on Friday at MIT, starting at 6:00 p.m.

## O'BRIEN AND PALMER REACH 1,000-POINT MARK IN ONE WEEK SPAN

February 17, 2000

Seniors Lloyd Palmer (Dorchester, MA/Cushing Academy) and Bill O'Brien (Taunton, MA/Northfield Mt. Hermon H.S.) became the fifth and sixth Lyon players, respectively in school history to reach the 1,000-point mark, as each scored their coveted point within a one week span. In doing so, both players led the Wheaton men's basketball team to wins over New England Women's and Men's Athletic Conference (NEWMAC) opponents Worcester Polytechnic Institute (WPI) and Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT).



On Tuesday, February 8 at Emerson Gymnasium in Norton, Palmer recorded his 1,000th point on a streaking right-handed layup with 5:12 to play in the contest. He completed his memorable night with his first double-double of the season, tallying 12 points and grabbing 12 boards in a 75-47 triumph over WPI. Palmer only needed 11 points to reach that plateau.

A four-year starter for the Lyons, Palmer has played in all 21 games for the Lyons this season, while starting in 18 of them. Palmer, who was named to the All-NEWMAC First Team as a junior and chosen as a 1999 NCAA Division III Preseason All-American Honorable Mention, is third in scoring and second in rebounding on the team this year with 9.2 ppg and 5.3 rpg, respectively. He is second in blocked shots and tied for second in steals. Palmer also is on the NEWMAC leader board for field goal percentage at 44.2% (76-172 FG).

Palmer, who was recruited for his defensive abilities, will rank in the top five in four statistical categories by the time he graduates. He's the fifth all-time leading scorer, second all-time leading rebounder, second all-time in steals and second all-time in blocked shots.

Exactly one week later after Palmer made his historical mark, O'Brien delivered his 1,000th point on Tuesday, February 15 by burying his only three-point basket of the night with 11:52 remaining at MIT. Entering the contest in Cambridge, O'Brien needed only seven points to reach that plateau and when the final buzzer sounded he hit his season average of nine points in his team's 73-65 victory.

O'Brien, who is second in the Wheaton record book for three-pointers made, is currently among the conference leaders in three-point percentage and field goal percentage, shooting 38.1% (32-84 three-point FG) from behind the three-point arc and 46.3% (68-147 FG) from the field. He also is second on the team in free throw percentage at a solid 75.0% (21-28 FT). O'Brien has played in all of Wheaton's 21 games this season, while starting in nine.

These two seniors will look to extend the Lyons' first four-game winning streak tonight at 7:00 p.m. in a crucial league contest at Babson College. Wheaton is in a four-way tie for first place with Coast Guard, Clark University and Springfield College with only two games to play. The Lyons, at 14-7 overall and 7-3 in the NEWMAC, will finish the 1999-2000 campaign at home this Saturday, February 19 at 4:00 p.m. against conference rival Springfield College.

### **PALMER SURPASSES 1,000-POINT PLATEAU AS LYONS WIN; LEADS WHEATON TO 75-47 TRIUMPH OVER WPI**

February 8, 2000

Senior forward Lloyd Palmer (Dorchester, MA/Cushing Academy) became only the fifth Lyon player in school history to surpass the 1,000-point plateau, as he led the Wheaton men's basketball team to a 75-47 conference triumph over Worcester Polytechnic Institute (WPI) on Tuesday at Emerson Gymnasium. The Lyons have now beaten the Engineers on four straight occasions by an average of 30.3 ppg, lifting their home record to 7-2.



The Lyons trailed through the first 6:24 of play down 14-12, as WPI center Dana Griffin (Clinton, MA/Clinton H.S.) tallied eight of the Engineers' first 11 points. The contest seesawed back and forth for the next three minutes with Wheaton trailing 18-17 midway through the first half. For the Lyons entered senior guard Bill O'Brien (Taunton, MA/Northfield Mt. Hermon H.S.), providing the needed scoring spark by knocking down three long-range three-point baskets en route to a 17-2 Wheaton charge and 30-20 advantage with just under three minutes to play. The Lyons extended their lead to 11 points, taking a 36-25 lead into the half. Through the first 20 minutes, Wheaton stole the ball seven times, while forcing 11 WPI turnovers.

Wheaton continued its streak into the second half, scoring the first 10 points for a 45-25 lead. The Engineers cut the Lyons advantage to 16 points on one occasion, but would get no closer as Wheaton led by as many as 30 points. Palmer recorded his 1,000th point on a streaking right-handed lay up off the assist from sophomore forward Sam Ackah (New Bedford, MA/New Bedford H.S.). At that point of the game, the Lyons had the upper hand at 64-41 with 5:27 to play.

O'Brien led three Wheaton players in double-figure scoring, as he tallied 13 points (4-6 FG, 3-5 three-point FG, 2-2 FT). Palmer completed his monumental night with his first double-double of the season, scoring 12 points and grabbing 12 boards. Senior guard Arnulfo DeLaCruz (Milton, MA/Milton H.S.) added 11 points (4-6 FG, 1-1 three-point FG, 2-2 FT).

For WPI, Griffin led all scorers and rebounders in the contest, tallying game-high's of 15 points and 16 rebounds. The only other Engineer player to score double-digits was sophomore forward Greg LaCamera (Lakeville, MA/Apponequet Regional H.S.) with 10 points. The league's leading scorer at 20.0 ppg, senior forward Greg Burnett (Phillipston, MA/Narragansett Regional H.S.), was held to three points while shooting 0-12 FG and 3-4 FT.

With the win, the Lyons improved their overall record to 12-7, including a 6-3 mark in the New England Women's and Men's Athletic Conference (NEWMAC). WPI has now dropped eight of its last nine outings, falling to 4-11 and 1-7. Wheaton will have a change of pace in its schedule this Thursday, as the team faces non-league opponent Elms College on the road, beginning at 7:00 p.m.

## LYONS BASKETBALL TROUNCES BABSON COLLEGE, 70-54; MEN WIN TWO STRAIGHT AND FOUR OF LAST FIVE CONTESTS

January 27, 2000

The Wheaton College men's basketball team continued its winning ways on Thursday night, as the Lyons led by as many as 24 points, beating conference foe Babson College, 70-54 in Emerson Gymnasium. With the victory, Wheaton improved its home record to 6-2, while snapping Babson's three-game winning streak.



In the opening half, the game developed into a seesaw battle that saw each team's leading scorer shine. The score was 13-10 in Wheaton's favor and the clock stood at 14:03, with Lyons' senior center Justin Lefkowski (Torrington, CT/Torrington H.S.) having nine points and Beavers' sophomore forward Brian McCarthy (East Sandwich, MA/Philips-Exeter H.S.) contributing seven points. But Wheaton would put the game out of reach, limiting its opponents to a mere three field goals the remainder of the half. The Lyons outscored Babson 21-9 in that span, including a 9-0 stretch midway through the half. Wheaton went into the locker room with a 34-19 lead, mostly due to its defensive pressure, forcing the Beavers to turn the ball over 14 times.

The Beavers could only narrow the Lyon advantage to 12 points at 37-25 in the early minutes of the second half, and Wheaton quickly extended its lead, going on an 18-6 run and taking its biggest advantage of the game at 55-31 with 11:18 to play. Babson cut into the Lyon lead, scoring 10 straight points over the next 2:40 on the strength of sophomore guard Evan Carlson's (Weston, MA/Weston H.S.) two lay-ups and three-point basket. Following the Beavers' run, the Lyons managed to put together a 10-0 run of their own to lead 65-41 with just fewer than five minutes to play. Babson cut the margin to 14 points yet again, but at this point the game was already decided.

Lefkowski led Wheaton in scoring, as he posted a game-high 18 points (8-13 FG) with six rebounds. Luke Gordon (Cherry Valley, MA/St. Peter's Marian H.S.) added 10 points, a game-best seven rebounds, four steals and three assists, while Arnulfo DeLaCruz (Milton, MA/Milton H.S.) led the passing attack with eight assists along with eight points.

McCarthy and freshman Chris Michalowski (Bristol, CT/St. Paul H.S.) both scored nine points, with Michalowski also grabbing four boards in the loss.

The Wheaton men have caught fire of late, winning two straight games and four of five, raising its mark to 10-5 overall and 4-1 in NEWMAC play. After winning three consecutive contests, the loss for Babson drops them to 6-9 and 2-3 in the conference. Wheaton will travel to the birthplace of basketball on Saturday, January 29, to face highly-regarded Springfield College in a conference game. Tip-off is scheduled for 3:00 p.m.

### **MEN'S HOOPS NEVER TRAILED IN 64-52 WIN OVER MIT; MARKS FOURTH CONSECUTIVE VICTORY AGAINST ENGINEERS**

January 25, 2000

The Wheaton College men's basketball team opened up its game on a 7-0 run and never looked back as the Lyons won for the fourth straight time over conference opponent Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT), 64-52 on Tuesday night. Wheaton raised its home record to 5-2, while the Engineers have lost four straight games and seven of their last nine.



The first half belonged to the Lyons as they held an 11-2 advantage with 16:27 to play. MIT bounced right back with six straight points to close the gap to within three. But senior guard Bill O'Brien (Taunton, MA/Northfield Mt. Hermon H.S.) provided additional scoring power for Wheaton with eight of the team's next 10 points, which included back-to-back three-point baskets. The Lyons extended their lead to 15 points at 25-10 with 8:17 on the clock, but the Engineers' junior center Craig Heffernan (Red Bluff, CA/Mercy H.S.) single-handedly kept MIT in the ball game, as he had 13 of the team's first 17 points. The Engineers would get no closer than eight points, as the Lyons entered the half with a 36-27 cushion.

In the second half, the Engineers got two quick baskets to cut their deficit to five points at 36-31. The contest remained in reach for MIT midway through the second half, as they trailed 45-39. From that point on, the Lyon defense kick into gear, holding the Engineers' offense without a field goal over the next eight minutes. During that span, O'Brien ignited the offense yet again with eight of Wheaton's next 11 points to push its lead out to a game-best 16 points (56-40) with 4:16 to play. MIT would narrow the Wheaton lead to seven on two occasions, but it proved to be not enough as the Lyons welcomed the 12-point victory.

O'Brien led the way for Wheaton with a team-high 19 points (6-8 FG, 4-6 three-point FG, 3-4 FT) along with five rebounds. Rounding out the double-figure scoring was sophomore forward Sam Ackah (New Bedford, MA/New Bedford H.S.) with 14 markers (6-8 FG) and senior guard Arnulfo DeLaCruz (Milton, MA/Milton H.S.) with 11 points and a team-high tying six rebounds. Senior point guard Tim Allen (Springfield, MA/Longmeadow H.S.) paced the Lyons with a game-high four assists and a team-high tying six rebounds.

Heffernan, who was coming off a 22-point performance against Clark University, led the Engineers with a game-best 25 points (11-19 FG) and five rebounds.

The Lyons have won three out of their last four games, improving their overall record to 9-5 and 3-1 in the conference. MIT falls to 6-9 and 1-4 in the loss. Wheaton will return home this Thursday, January 27, while remaining in conference play against the Babson College Beavers. Tip-off is slated for 7:00 p.m.

### WHEATON STUNS CONNECTICUT COLLEGE IN MEN'S HOOPS, 92-89

January 20, 2000

The Wheaton College men's basketball team led by as many as thirteen points in the second half to hang on and knock off highly-touted Connecticut College, 92-89 in Emerson Gymnasium on Thursday night. The Camels, who were last year's NCAA Tournament Final Four participants, have lost back to back games for the first time all season. The Lyons, avenging last year's loss in New London, CT, have won three of their last four contests.



The Lyons started the game right where they left off their last game against WPI, shooting three-pointers, as sophomore guard Luke Gordon (Cherry Valley, MA) buried the team's first to take an early 5-2 lead. Connecticut then went on a 11-2 run thanks to seven points coming from Camels' leading scorer Kareem Tatum (Worcester, MA). With a 13-7 advantage, Connecticut showed many signs of extending that lead, but Wheaton responded with great defensive intensity and solid shooting. Their pressure defense, which was led by Jarrett Lewis' (Detroit, MI) six steals and Peter Butler's (Hamden, CT) presence on the floor, kept the Lyons within reach as they never trailed by more than seven points. Wheaton was down 42-35 with 8:20 on the clock, but went on a 7-2 run to close the gap to two at 44-42 at the intermission. Both teams finished the first half shooting 60% or higher from the field, as Wheaton made 63% (15-24 FG) of its attempts while the Camels shot 60% (15-25 FG).

The two teams came out of the half in a hard-fought struggle as the contest was in a dead tie at 55 points apiece with 14:15 remaining. During the next Camel possession, Arnulfo DeLaCruz (Milton, MA) stole the pass and dished to Lloyd Palmer (Dorchester, MA), who completed the three-point play the old fashioned way. From that point on, the Wheaton men led in the game's entirety, while holding Connecticut without a field goal over a seven-minute stretch midway through the half. Amazingly, when Connecticut's Bill Bassett (Arvada, CO) hit the team's first field goal in that span at the 7:32 mark, the Camels only trailed by three points at 70-67. Wheaton then put the game away on a 14-4 run and the game's biggest lead at 84-71 (3:43) and never looked back as they survived Connecticut's last-minute scare down the stretch. The Lyons finished the contest shooting a season-high 60% (29-48 FG) from the field and 73% (30-41 FT) from the free throw line.

Wheaton had four players score in double-figures, led by Palmer's 20 points (8-11 FG) with a game-best nine rebounds and four blocks. Other Lyon players in double-digits were DeLaCruz's 19 points, Justin Lefkowski's (Torrington, CT) 15 markers and Lewis' 12 points.

Connecticut was paced by Tatum, who scored his 1,000th career point in the game, with a game-best 21 points and team-high six rebounds.

With the win, Wheaton upped its record to 8-4 overall, while the Camels fell to 8-3 on the season. The Lyons will look to win their third straight contest, as they travel to Medford, MA to face NESCAC opponent Tufts University on Saturday, January 22 at 2:00 p.m.

The Wheaton College men's basketball team continued its conference play in the New England Women's and Men's Athletic Conference (NEWMAC) on Saturday afternoon, as they fell short of the defending NEWMAC champions Clark University, 86-74 in Emerson Gymnasium.



The Cougars jumped out to a quick 5-0 lead early in the opening half, but Wheaton quickly responded with an 11-0 streak of its own, capped off by a Justin Lefkowski (Torrington, CT/Torrington H.S.) lay in at the 16:29 minute mark. The Lyons used their hot first half shooting (.500, 15-30 FG) and nine steals to open up their biggest lead of the game at 28-16 with 6:30 remaining on the clock. Clark bounced back on a 13-2 run over a four minute span to close the game within one at 30-29. Wheaton's freshman guard Jarrett Lewis (Detroit, MI/S. Kent School), who was coming off a career-high point performance against Coast Guard, gave the Lyons some breathing room as he drilled a three-pointer to extend the difference to four points at 33-29. The Cougars made 10 of their final 13 free throws and 28-34 FT (.824) overall. The Lyons shot 16-30 (.533) from the charity stripe.

Lloyd Palmer (Dorchester, MA/Cushing Academy) led Wheaton in the scoring and rebounding columns with 16 points and six rebounds. Arnulfo DeLaCruz (Milton, MA/Milton H.S.) rounded out the double-figure scoring with a season-high 15 points.

Clark was paced by its leading scorer Rob Robledo (Newton, MA/Newton H.S.) with a game-best 21 points (6-10 FG, 3-6 three-pt FG, 6-6 FT).

Today's loss drops Wheaton's record to 6-4 overall, including a 1-1 mark in conference play. The Cougars improved their mark to 7-3 and 1-0 on the year. The Lyons will next visit Worcester, MA on Tuesday, as they will face conference opponent WPI. Tip off is scheduled for 7:30 p.m.

The opening half was a very evened match between the two conference foes as the game experienced nine ties and nine different lead changes. Lefkowski, who was named to the all-tournament team, scored 14 points and grabbed three rebounds before fouling out. In addition to leading the Lyons in points, he held Salem State center Gus White (Dorchester, MA/Boston English) to only nine points on the night.

In the consolation final played earlier in the day, Maine Maritime Academy rode all-tournament Jed Johnson's (Clinton, ME) 34 point and 15 rebound performance en route to a 93-90 double OT win over Endicott College. Maine Maritime led by a score of 46-30 at half, but the Power Gulls battled back to make it a contest as they shot 23-51 FG (.451) for the second half and overtime periods. Endicott junior Eric Simonelli (Duxbury, MA) finished with 34 points and 11 rebounds in the losing effort for the Gulls. Endicott's Jamal Francis (Dorchester, MA) was chosen for the all-tournament team. Francis finished the day with 15 points, six rebounds and eight assists.

Wheaton now must hit the road to face Brandeis University this coming Tuesday, November 23 in a non-conference game. Tip off is slated for 7 p.m.

Salem also got a strong performance from center Gus White (Dorchester, MA/Boston English). White tallied 13 points and grabbed 12 boards before getting into foul trouble. Endicott sophomore Jamal Francis (Dorchester, MA) finished with 13 points to lead the Gulls.

Endicott and Maine Maritime will play in the consolation tomorrow at 2 p.m., and will be followed by Salem State and Wheaton in the final at 4 p.m. Both games will be played at Wheaton's Emerson Gymnasium.
