## CONNECTICUT COLLEGE VICTORIOUS OVER WHEATON, 156-111 IN MEN'S SWIMMING FINALE

February 10, 2001

The Wheaton College men's swimming and diving team lost their final regular season dual swim meet this afternoon, as the Connecticut College Camels were victorious, 156-111 in Balfour Natatorium. The Lyons finished the year at 2-8, while Connecticut improved to 2-7 overall.



Freshman Chris Hurley (Belfast, ME) took part in all three Wheaton victories, as he captured wins in the 200 freestyle and 50 butterfly events, while swimming a leg on the first-place 200 free relay team with classmate Patrick Sagui (Westwood, MA), senior Chris Bransfield (Middletown, CT) and junior Chris Peterson (Ashland, MA). Hurley's time of 25.29 in the 50 fly was a season-best.

Also meeting season-best stature was Peterson in the 100 breaststroke in 1:09.30, good enough for second place among four competitors. First-year athlete John Lovett (Longmeadow, MA) posted a pair of personal-best times in the 500 free (6:08.82) and 1000 free (12:36.52) events.

The Lyon men finish their year the weekend of Friday, February 23, when Wheaton travels to Springfield College for the third annual New England Women's and Men's Athletic Conference (NEWMAC) Championship. Switching to a three-day format for the first time ever, the meet will begin at 12:00 p.m. on Friday for swimming trials and conclude Sunday at 6:30 p.m. with the swimming finals.

## TRINITY DEFEATS WHEATON SWIM TEAMS IN DUAL MEET

January 27, 2001

The Wheaton College men's and women's swim teams both fell in defeat Saturday afternoon to Trinity College in Balfour Natatorium. On the women's side in a meet that went down to the final events, the Bantams won their first meet of the year by a final count of 154-145, dropping Wheaton's mark to 3-7. The men suffered a 149-100 loss, as Trinity improved to 2-5.



Despite capturing victories in nine of the meet's 16 events, the women came up just shy of the Bantams, as they were led by a pair of juniors, captain Robin Shea (Belmont, MA/Belmont H.S.) and Erin Shepherd (Hamilton, MA). Shea was a part of two individual wins and one relay victory, setting a personal-best time in the 1650 freestyle (18:47.04) while also winning the 100 back and 100 individual medley and swimming a leg in the 200 free relay. Shepherd was victorious in multiple events, posting a personal record in the 100 breaststroke (1:13.40) while earning a first place finish in the 50 breast and part of a victory with the 200 medley relay team.

Other winners for the Lyon women were Ali Bialeck (Manchester, CT/Manchester H.S.) in the 50 freestyle, in addition to her part in the 200 medley relay and 200 freestyle relay victories. Senior captain and diver Julie King (Natick, MA) also recorded a top score in the one-meter dive for the host squad. Freshman Katie Levine (Needham, MA) contributed significant points with a triumph in the 50 backstroke and personal-best time and second place finish in the 500 freestyle.

Freshman Chris Hurley (Belfast, ME) delivered a pair of victories for the men, winning multiple events in the 100 butterfly (56.26) and 500 freestyle (5:15.54). He was .32 of a second off the school record in the 500 free. Other strong second place finishes came from senior Chris Bransfield (Middletown, CT), sophomore captain Chris Peterson (Ashland, MA), sophomore Nick Luise (Bloomfield, NJ) and a tandem of freshmen in John Lovett (Longmeadow, MA) and Patrick Sagui (Westwood, MA).

The Wheaton men and women will part ways for their final regular season dual meets, as the Lyon women compete at home on Wednesday, February 7 against Simmons College, beginning at 7:00 p.m. For the men, they are off until Friday the 10th, when they will face Conn. College at 1:30 p.m.

## WHEATON SWIM TEAMS RETURN TO ACTION AND SPLIT WITH UMASS-DARTMOUTH IN DUAL MEET

January 16, 2001

After a five and a half week lull of winter break, the Wheaton College men's and women's swimming and diving teams returned to action and split with UMass-Dartmouth in a dual meet Tuesday night in Balfour Natatorium.

Led by freshman Chris Hurley's (Belfast, ME) multiple event wins, the Lyon men picked up their second victory of the year by a final of 90-64, while the women went down fighting in a 170-130 defeat to the Corsairs. The men improved to 2-4 and the women fell to 2-5 on the season.



Hurley finished first in the 100 individual medley event with a personal-best time of 59.67 and 100 freestyle in a season-best 51.23 after beginning the evening as part of the winning 200 medley relay team. Freshman John Lovett (Longmeadow, MA) also was victorious in a pair of events, including a career-best time in the 1000 freestyle (12:38.93) and a win in the 100 backstroke (1:10.69).

Other winners for Wheaton were sophomores Patrick Sagui (Westwood, MA) and Chris Peterson (Ashland, MA) in the 50 backstroke and 50 breaststroke, respectively. Sagui and Peterson were also members of the winning 200 medley relay. Junior Dan Foxman (Bow, NH) contributed to the victory, as he led all divers in the one meter event.

On the women's team, junior Robin Shea (Belmont, MA/Belmont H.S.) continued to shine in posting multiple-event wins and personal-best times in the 1000 freestyle (11:18.04) and 500 freestyle (5:37.13) races. Junior Erin Shepherd (Hamilton, MA) out distanced all competitors in the 50 breaststroke, performing a career-high time of 33.50. She also earned a personal-best in the 100 breaststroke (1:14.22) and a second place finish.

Rounding out career-high events was first-year swimmer Katie Levine (Needham, MA), as she was clocked at 2:14.18 in the 200 freestyle, good enough for second place. Senior Ali Bialeck (Manchester, CT/Manchester H.S.) contributed significantly to Wheaton's narrow defeat by picking up individual wins in the 50 and 100 free events, while also swimming a leg on the top 200 medley relay team with Shepherd, Levine and Megan Sidoti (Middletown, CT). The time of 1:59.19 was a season best for the quartet of swimmers.

On Friday, January 19 the Wheaton teams will travel to Division II Bentley College, where they will face a pair of undefeated teams at 5:00 p.m.

## **SHEA AND HURLEY LEAD WHEATON SWIMMING AND DIVING TEAMS IN SWEEP OVER GORDON COLLEGE**

December 1, 2000

The Wheaton College men's and women's swimming and diving teams swept Gordon College Friday evening in Balfour Natatorium, as the Lyons nipped the Fighting Scots in dual meet competition. Earning their first win of the young season, the men edged Gordon, 122-117 to improve to 1-3, while the women moved to 2-3 in their 135-125 victory.



Junior Robin Shea (Belmont, MA/Belmont H.S.) demonstrated her consistency this season by once again posting multiple-event wins, which included the 200 freestyle, 100 individual medley and 200 backstroke events. First-year swimmer Katie Levine (Needham, MA) enjoyed a pair of victories in the 50 back and 50 free, while also contributing to Wheaton's first place finish in the 200 freestyle relay with teammates Ali Bialeck (Manchester, CT/Manchester H.S.), Megan Sidoti (Middletown, CT) and Maggie Malsch (Georgetown, ME).

In addition to Sidoti's relay finish, she captured top honors in the 50-meter butterfly. Junior Erin Shepherd (Hamilton, MA) added critical points in the 50 breaststroke with a first place gathering and the contingent of Shea, Shepherd, Sidoti and Bialeck were also winners in the 200 medley relay. The blue and white divers, consisting of seniors Julie King (Natick, MA) and Emily Henderson (Cohasset, MA), won the one and three meter dive events, respectively.

For the men, freshman Chris Hurley (Belfast, ME) captured a trio of wins in the 100 and 200- meter freestyle and 100 butterfly events. Sophomore Patrick Sagui (Westwood, MA) was also successful in freestyle competition, picking up wins in the 50 and 1000-meter events, respectively. Sophomore co-captain Chris Peterson (Ashland, MA) defeated all opponents in the 100 individual medley, while freshman John Lovett (Longmeadow, MA) was victorious in the 50 back. First-year athlete Matthew Squires (Rochester, NY) contributed with two wins in the one and three meter dives.

The Lyons return to action one week from today, as they will travel to Cambridge, Mass. for a dual meet with MIT, beginning at 5:00 p.m. Following the MIT meet, the Wheaton men and women will be off for the holiday break until Thursday, January 16, when they host the UMass-Dartmouth Corsairs. The meet will start at 6:00 p.m. in Balfour Natatorium.

## WHEATON SWIMMING AND DIVING TEAMS FALL TO CLARK UNIVERSITY IN DUAL MEET HOME OPENER

November 15, 2000

The Wheaton College men's and women's swimming teams each were defeated in dual meet competition on Wednesday night, as the Lyons fell short of Clark University in the 2000-01 home opener. Dropping their second meet of the season, the women bowed to the Cougars, 126-104 while the men lost by a count of 110-78.

On the women's side, the meet was highlighted by junior Robin Shea's (Belmont, MA/Belmont H.S.) multiple-event wins, capturing victories in all three of her events including the 1000 freestyle, 200 individual medley and 200 backstroke.

In addition to Shea's all-around solid performance, senior Alison Bialeck (Manchester, CT/Manchester H.S.) led the women's team in the 50-meter freestyle competition, as she landed a time of 25.61. Bialeck also contributed to the Wheaton effort with a pair of runner-up finishes in the 100 freestyle and 400 medley relay with teammates Katie Levine (Needham, MA), Erin Shepherd (Hamilton, MA) and Megan Sidoti (Middletown, CT).

For the men's squad, freshman Chris Hurley (Belfast, ME) led all competitors in the 200 freestyle and 100 butterfly events. Aside from a pair of victories for the first-year swimmer, Hurley assisted teammates Buck Crowe (Birmingham, AL), co-captain Chris Peterson (Ashland, MA) and Patrick Sagui (Westwood, MA) in earning a strong second place finish in the 400 medley relay.

Novice diver Matthew Squires (Rochester, NY) paced the home team with two wins in the one and three meter dives, while freshmen John Lovett (Longmeadow, MA) and Todd Pang (Honolulu, HI) posted commendable performances in the 500 freestyle and 200 breaststroke events, respectively.

The Lyon women will return home this Saturday to face New England Women's and Men's Athletic Conference (NEWMAC) rival Smith College in dual meet competition, beginning at 1:00 p.m. The Wheaton men will rejoin their counterparts on Friday, December 1 in a home meet against Gordon College held at Balfour Natatorium at 5:00 p.m.
