Minimum courses required: **10**, including at least 2 courses at the 300-level or above, PHIL 401 in the senior year. Not more than 2 courses at the 100-level (other than Logic) may count toward the major.

**Note:** Students wishing to take an introductory course in Philosophy are advised to take PHIL 101, *Introduction to Philosophy*, PHIL 111, *Ethics*, or PHIL 121, *Individual and Society*.
