

## How to Install Mathematica on your Macintosh computer

### *Read this before you begin:*

You need administrative privileges on your computer to install Mathematica.

Wheaton has a license to run Mathematica on any computer that is connected to the Wheaton network. If you are off-campus, you can use [VPN](#) to connect.

When you're done:

Only 30 Wheaties can use Mathematica at the same time.

Please Quit Mathematica, so your friends and professors can get access when they need it.

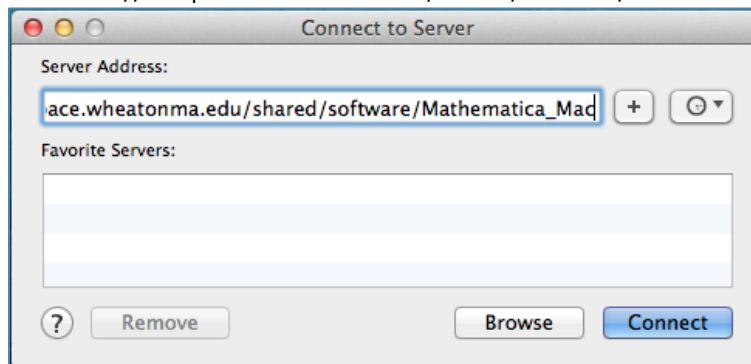
### *Install Mathematica*

From the *Apple Finder*

Choose *Go*

Choose *Connect To Server*

Enter this Server Address: `smb://netspace.wheatonma.edu/shared/software/Mathematica_Mac`



You may be asked to log onto the Wheaton server:

Choose *Registered User*

Enter your wID and password

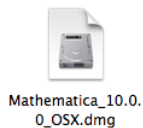
Click the *Connect* button



The *Mathematica\_Mac* folder will open.

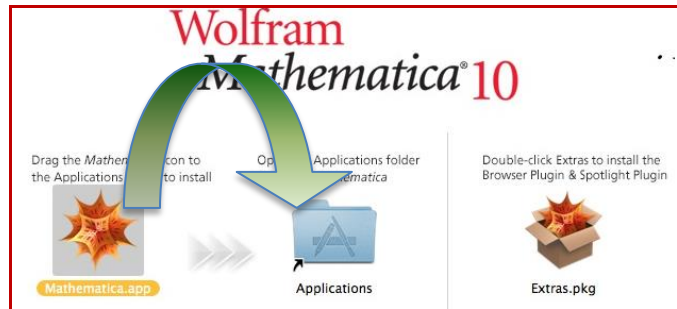
Drag the Mathematica....dmg file to your desktop.

Double-click the Mathematica...dmg icon on your desktop to open the file.

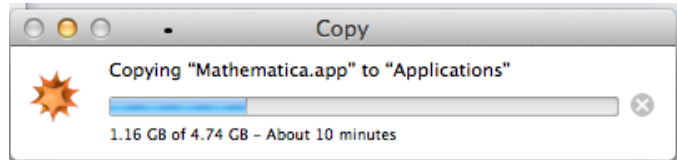


This will take a few minutes.

When the Wolfram Mathematica window opens,  
Drag the Mathematica icon onto the Applications folder.

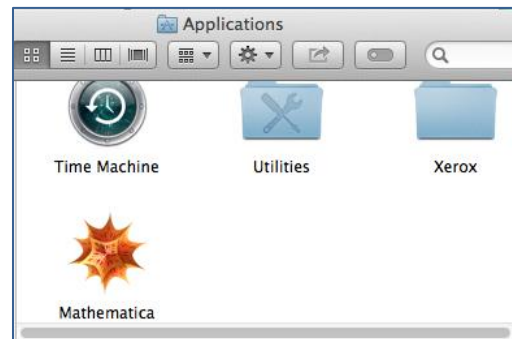


It could take many minutes.



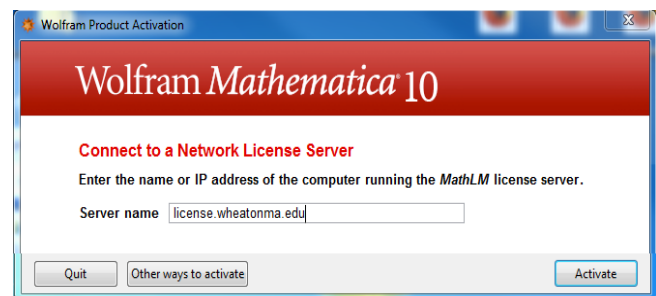
### Activate Mathematica

If Mathematica does not open automatically,  
Go to the *Applications* folder  
Open *Mathematica*



In the *Wolfram Product Activation* window,  
Click the *Other ways to activate* button.  
Choose *Connect to a license server*

For Server name, enter: license.wheatonma.edu  
Click the *Activate* button



Check the box for *I accept the terms of this agreement*.  
Click the *OK* button.  
Registration is now complete and Mathematica.app is ready to use.

In the future, simply open Mathematica from the Applications folder.

**Remember to Quit when you finish, to allow others to use the software!**
