If you plan to be abroad during the Spring semester of your Junior year, you must take this course in the Spring of your Sophomore year unless your study abroad program offers an approved equivalent.) _____

3. ANTH 302: Research Methods
(This course must be taken prior to senior year, and is offered in the Fall of each year. Some study abroad programs may offer a course that would fulfill this requirement, though it is highly desirable that you take this course at Wheaton. Consult your advisor if you plan to be abroad during your junior year in the Fall semester.) _____

(Fall semester, senior year) _____
