REQUIRED DOCUMENTS FOR DS-2019 ISSUANCE

The following documents are required for Wheaton College to issue a DS-2019 (Certificate of Eligibility for Exchange Visitor (J-1) Status)

- Wheaton College exchange visitor application form
- Housing Survey (students only; TAs will not be in residence halls)
- Copy of passport biometric page
- Bank statement or school letter
 - Original bank statement showing funds to cover the cost of the time the student is at Wheaton or letter from the institution on letterhead stating that the institution will be covering the cost of tuition per exchange agreement.
- CV (Resume)
- Personal statement (include academic goal and the reason for applying to the program)
- Two recommendation letters
- Copy of Official Transcript
- Proof of English language proficiency (TOEFL, IELTS, Skype Interview, etc.) as required by the U.S. Department of State.
 - Original TOEFL scores, English language certification or other English language test scores or documentation (letter on letterhead) from the home institution proving that the student has the required English language proficiency.
