STATE NOTICES

<u>California applicants or employees only</u>: By signing the Disclosure Form, you also acknowledge receipt of the DISCLOSURE REGARDING BACKGROUND INVESTIGATION PURSUANT TO CALIFORNIA LAW.

<u>Minnesota applicants or employees only</u>: You have the right in most circumstances to submit a written request to the consumer reporting agency for a complete and accurate disclosure of the nature and scope of any consumer report the Company ordered about you.
