

Occupational Therapy (OT) Curricular Path

Minimum number of courses: 7

The below courses are meant to serve as a guide for **most** schools, but may lack some specific requirements as they are updated by the professions and individual schools. The course prerequisites for admission vary significantly across OT education programs. Visit the institutions' websites to determine what courses are required by each institution. Keep in mind that OT schools will require specific grades in all prerequisite courses.

Frequent Additional Courses

- Physics and/or Chemistry
