

If students are still dissatisfied after the decision of the appeal has been made, an appeal can then be made to Dolores Radlo, Dean of Advising.

The appeal should be made within 5 business days of notification of the decision of the appeal. The appeal should be submitted in writing and state the grounds for the appeal.

The review by the Dean of Advising will include meeting with the student, a meeting with the Director of Accessibility Services, and a review of the file and supporting documentation. They may also meet with other people with information on this issue.

Based on this review, the Dean of Advising will make a determination in writing to grant or deny the appeal and then forward the decision to the student and the Accessibility Services Director.
